**Avila Kilmurray** is a Dubliner who has worked in the community and voluntary sectors in Northern Ireland since 1975. She attended the all-Parties Northern Ireland conference in Amherst, Massachusetts that year. Avila has a long involvement in the Women's Movement and on anti-poverty issues. She was the first Women's Officer of Unite – the Transport & General Workers' Union – in Ireland and was Director of the Community Foundation for Northern Ireland from 1994-2014, when she managed programmes under the EU PEACE Programme. Avila was a founder member of the Northern Ireland Women's Coalition and a member of its Negotiating Team for the Belfast/Good Friday Agreement. She holds a PhD from Queens University and is author of 'Community Action in a Contested Society: The Story of Northern Ireland' (Lang 2017). She currently supports the work of the Social Change Initiative on peacebuilding, human rights and refugee/migrant activism.
