POLITICAL SCIENCE MAJOR REQUIREMENTS:

The Department of Political Science requires its majors to complete a minimum of 36 credits in Political Science including the Junior Year Writing and Integrative Experience courses. All coursework for the major must be taken for a letter grade and carry at least 3 credits, and no more than 5 transfer courses (or a maximum of 20 transfer credits) may count toward the major. Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA within the major as well as overall, at the University, to graduate.

INTRODUCTORY REQUIREMENT: Majors must complete three 100-level Political Science classes with a cumulative average of 2.0 across the three courses. Students must complete one course in each category:

UPPER-LEVEL REQUIREMENTS: Majors must take 24 credits of Political Science coursework at the 200-level or higher, 12 credits of which must be at the 300-level or higher. All courses must carry 3 or more credits. Junior Year Writing and the Integrative Experience may be counted toward these 24 credits. Not more than one of these courses can be an independent study course or a graded internship. Honors Capstone Research and Honors Capstone Thesis courses (POLISCI 499C & 499D) will both count toward the upper-level requirements. Honors Research, Honors Project, and Honors Thesis courses (POLISCI 499Y, 499P, 499T) do not count toward upper-level requirements.
