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LEGAL STUDIES MAJOR REQUIREMENTS:

Legal Studies requires its majors to complete a minimum of 33 credits including the Junior Year Writing and Integrative Experience courses. All coursework for the major must be taken for a letter grade and carry at least 3 credits, and no more than 2 transfer courses (or a maximum of 8 transfer credits) may count toward the major. Students must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA within the major as well as overall, at the University, to graduate.

INTRODUCTORY REQUIREMENT: Majors must complete LEGAL 250. This course is a pre-requisite for most of our 300 and 400-level courses.
